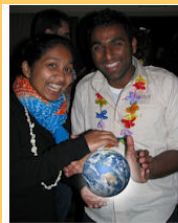

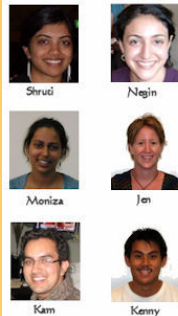

- **What do we want to achieve?**

 - IFMSA Exchange Program
