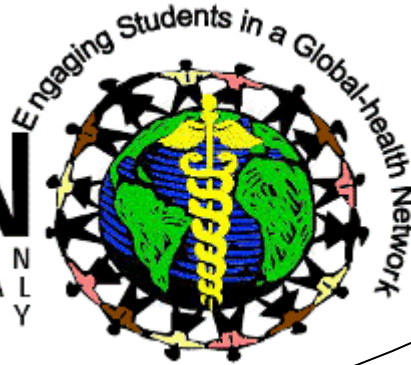

We look forward to making the Red Party bigger and better next year and in following years to come!




